

ATV, BOAT, AND SNOWMOBILE REGISTRATIONS:

Recreational vehicles can be registered at the town office Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., or online at https://apps1.web.maine.gov/online/atv_snow/index.htm.

ATV'S - Registrations expire June 30th each year.

Fees are: Resident season registration: \$45.00*
 Nonresident 7 day registration: \$75.00*
 Nonresident season registration: \$90.00*
 *Plus agent fee - \$1.00 for renewals and \$2.00 for new registrations.

BOATS - Registrations expire December 31st each year.

All watercraft are subject to excise tax. The amount of the tax is based on the length of the boat, the age of the boat, and the horsepower of the motor. The registration fee is based on the horsepower of the motor. An agent fee of \$1.00 is also collected. Owners of any watercraft located in Maine, including documented watercraft, must pay their annual excise tax.

- Maine residents pay the tax to the town where they reside.
- Non-residents or corporations pay the tax to the Maine town where the watercraft is principally moored, docked, or located.

SNOWMOBILES - Registrations expire June 30th each year.

Fees are: Resident season registration: \$45.00*
 Nonresident 3 day registration: \$49.00*
 Nonresident 10 day registration: \$75.00
 Nonresident season registration: \$99.00*
 *Plus agent fee - \$1.00 for renewals and \$2.00 for new registrations.

All snowmobiles operated in the State of Maine must be registered in Maine. The State of Maine no longer has reciprocity with any other state or province on snowmobile registrations.

If a boat, snowmobile, or ATV is purchased from a private person, please bring an old registration if available. It contains all the information needed to do a new registration. If an old registration is not available, please bring the ME number (registration number on the side of the boat or vehicle) and the serial numbers. A bill of sale is also required.

If a recreational vehicle is purchased from a dealership, proof of sales tax paid is required for the registration.
