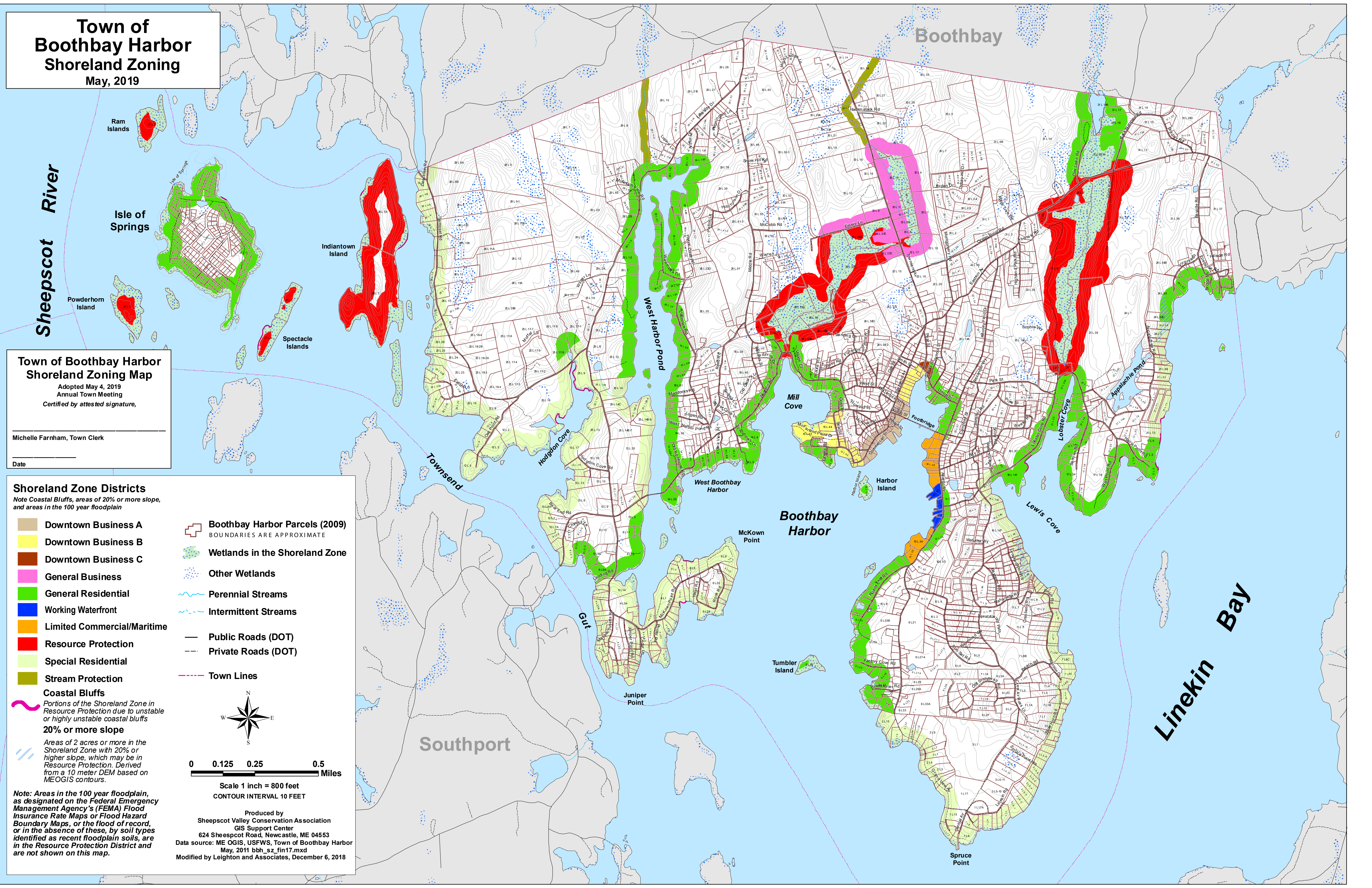

Shoreland Zone Districts

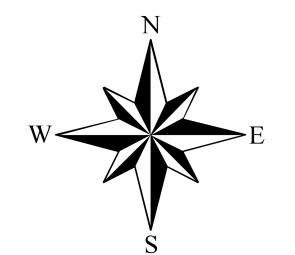
Note Coastal Bluffs, areas of 20% or more slope, and areas in the 100 year floodplain

Coastal Bluffs
Portions of the Shoreland Zone in Resource Protection due to unstable or highly unstable coastal bluffs 20% or more slope

Areas of 2 acres or more in the Shoreland Zone with 20% or higher slope, which may be in Resource Protection. Derived from a 10 meter DEM based on MEOGIS contours.
