In response to the following application(s,) pursuant to Maine Law Title 38 M.R.S.A. § 1022; on **September 25, 2023**, the Boothbay Harbor Board of Selectmen will hold a Public Hearing on site, and for the purpose of review the proposed placement of the following structure(s) in the waters of Boothbay Harbor. The hearing will be at the following time and location:

Nancy Rowe Rogers and the Revocable Living Trust of Marianne Berrigan Grant, Bridge House, applicant proposes to modify the existing permanent pier system, widening the existing pier at three locations. The proposed modifications include the installation of a 1.3 foot wide by 4.4 foot long pier extension at the northwest corner, a 4.5 foot wide by 9 foot long pier extension at the northeast corner, and a 5 foot wide by 4 foot long pier extension at the southeast corner.
