Public Participation Guidelines for Boothbay Harbor Select Board Meetings: Public forum is not intended to provide a forum for debate between members of the public nor between the public and the board. No public comment that embarrasses or attacks an individual or board member shall be allowed. People with disabilities or who have difficulty with the English language and who plan to attend the meeting should contact the town in advance of the meeting if they need a reasonable accommodation to participate, such as an interpreter or a person skilled in American Sign Language. The town will then request the information needed to decide exactly what kind of accommodation is necessary and reasonable for a particular individual and a particular meeting location.
